



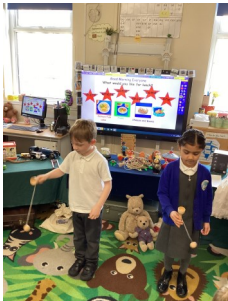
Dear all,

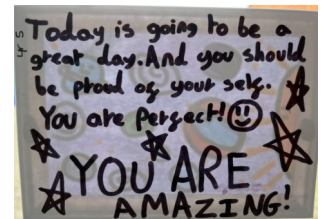
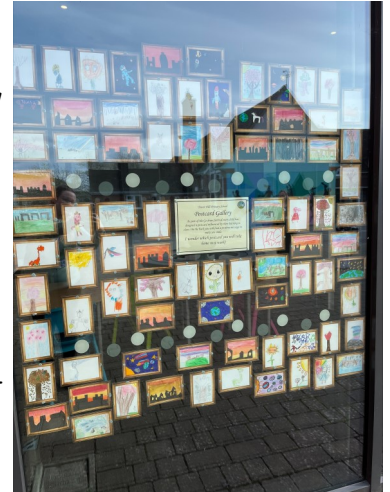

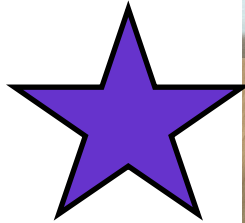
