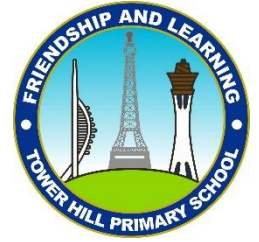

A Parent's Guide to myON



As part of our Accelerated Reader provision, your child has access to myON. This is a digital library containing thousands of exciting books.

Please use this guide to help you and your child access myON

Logging in

1. Go to www.myon.co.uk and click on myON Login in the top right-hand corner
2. Enter the school name, username and password (your child should have this. If you are unsure, please speak to your child's class teacher).

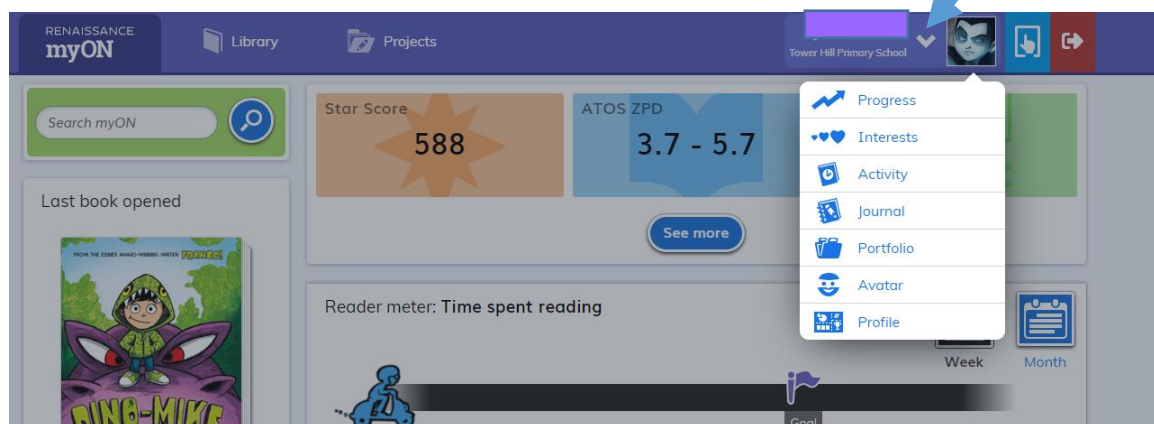
Your child will have practised logging in at school with their teacher to make sure that their username and password is working and so that they can have a look at the site and what is available.

myON login form with the following fields:

When your child logs in for the first time, they will be asked to complete an Interests Questionnaire so that myON can recommend books they will enjoy. They will have completed this at school but can update it at any point.

Click on this arrow and select Interests from the drop down menu to update the interests questionnaire. This can be done as frequently as you like to make sure recommended books are relevant.



myON Homepage

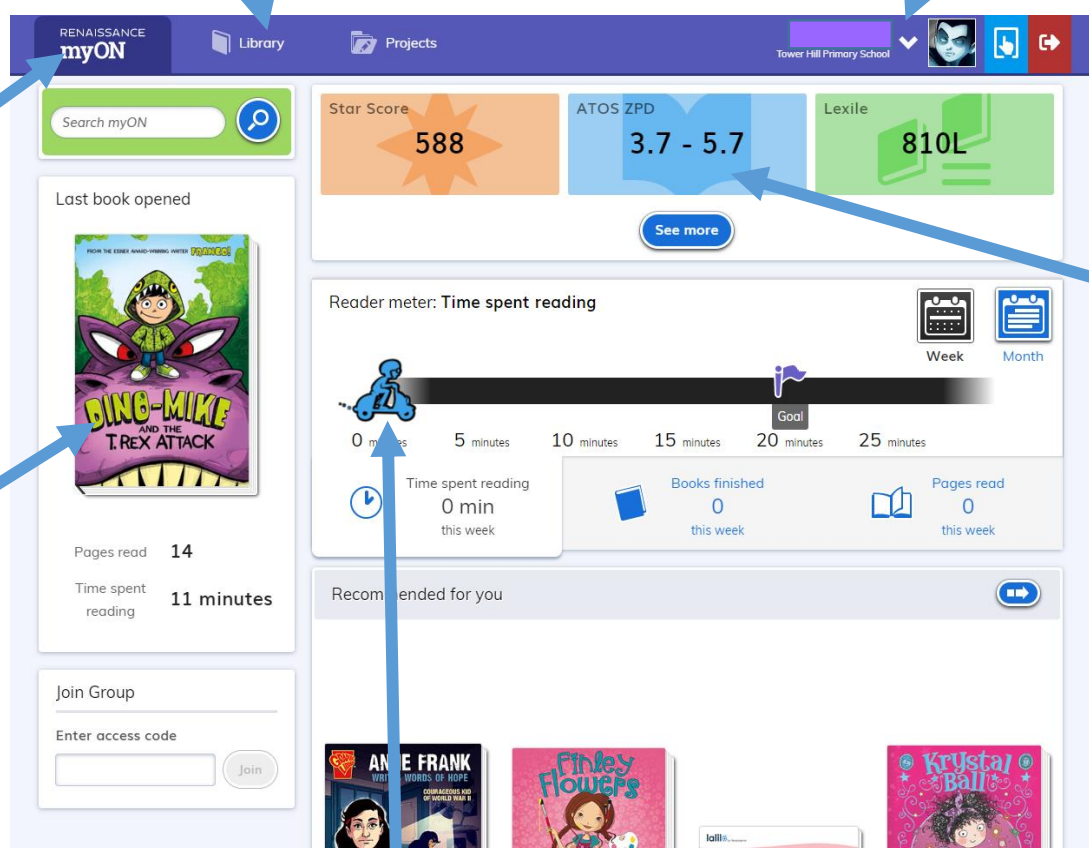
Your child's home page will look like this and contains all the information that you will need.

You can find new books here. Books are recommended by ZPD, year group, genre etc so everybody can find something they would like to read.

This is where you will find Account Information. Your child can change their avatar and update their interests here. You can keep track of the books they have read and how long they have spent reading.

This shows your child's current ZPD – this tells you the level of books that they are reading.

This character moves along each time your child reads a book on myON and changes as it moves. You can see how long they have read for and how many books they have read.

Reading a Book in myON

To read a book move the mouse cursor over the book. To open the book and start reading it and select
