Children of all ages learn best when they can see a purpose to what they are doing, when they can see that what they are doing is real and has meaning. With this at the forefront of their minds, teachers plan engaging and exciting lessons in all subjects.

When teaching using the RING approach, children often forget that they are learning as they become highly engaged in solving a problem, helping somebody or even cracking codes. The children are still learning the new skills and knowledge but often without realising it!!

In Year 1, the children went on a Bear Hunt to support their learning in writing and as a result produced some excellent written outcomes.
