

Awards at Tower Hill

Values Badges	These are given out each week in Celebration Assembly. One child from Key stage 1 and Key Stage 2 is chosen to receive each badge. The school values are: Respect, High Expectations, Achievement, Confidence, Fairness and Friendliness.
Dojos	Children are awarded Dojos by the adults in school for good work, effort and behaviour. When they have 50 Dojos (and multiples of) they will bring home a certificate to celebrate their achievements.
Headteacher's Smart Award	Miss Ovenden chooses one child from Key Stage 1 and one child from Key Stage 2 each week to receive the smart award - she looks for children wearing the correct school uniform, including black shoes and with smart hair.
Headteacher's Star Spotter	Miss Ovenden chooses one child from Key Stage 1 and one child from Key Stage 2 each week to receive the Headteacher's Star Spotter. This award is given to children who do things for other people without being asked and those children who show our values and follow school rules.
Class Star of the Week	Every week, class teachers choose their Class Star of the Week. This person is chosen for always showing school values and trying their best.
Class of the Week	A trophy is given out during Celebration Assembly to celebrate the two classes with the highest attendance.
Golden Pebbles	Every class has a pot of Golden Pebbles to fill. They have to work as a team to earn pebbles and when the pot is full, the children can decide on a treat which they enjoy as a whole class. A pyjama day and a good film is a popular choice!
Assembly Stars	The children earn assembly stars for showing respectful behaviour during our assembly time. When they have earnt 20 stars, they get a 15 minute extra playtime as a reward.
Governor's Trophy	At the end of each term, one child from Key Stage 1 and one child from Key Stage 2 is chosen by the staff and Governors to receive the trophy. This award is only given out three times a year, so is very special!
